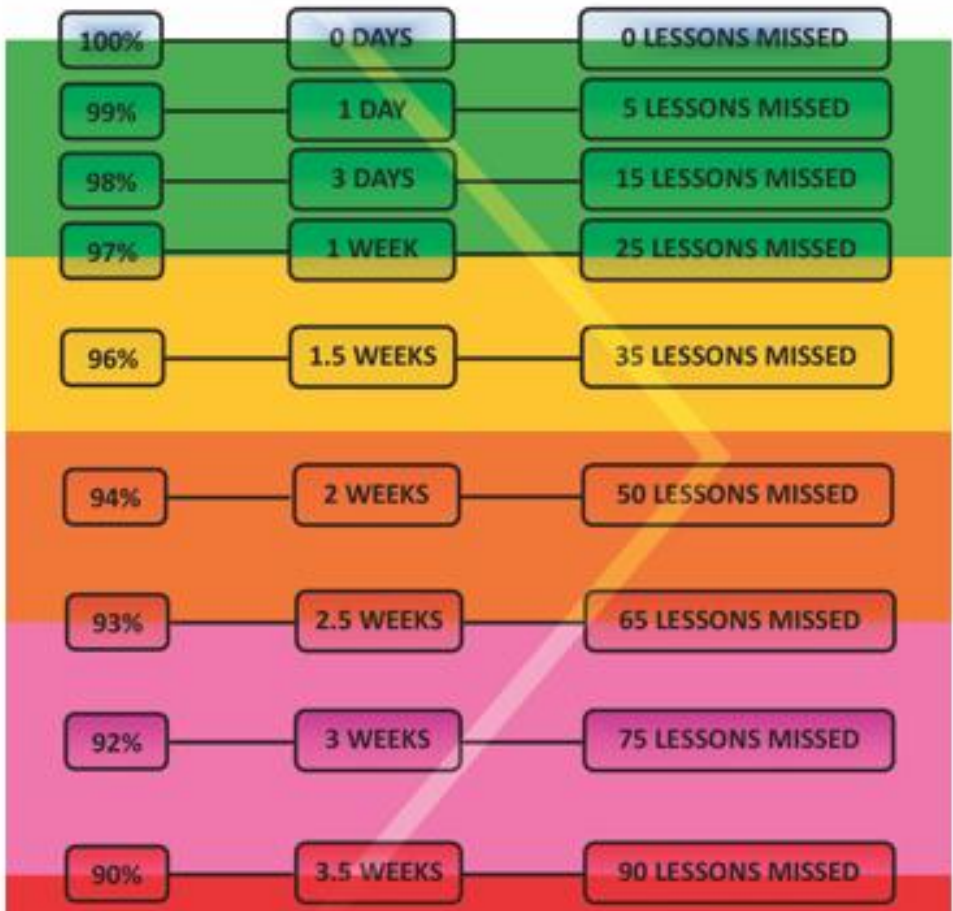
Attendance Diamond
